Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on Tuesday 21st March 2023

1. Apologies and approval of absences

a) planning applications

DC/22/04228 - conversion of barn at College Farm, Earls Green

It was confirmed that Portable Space containers being stored at Jackson's Farm without permission, will be removed when work at Red House Farm has been completed
